



Income eligibility for the Naperville Park District Scholarship program is based on guidelines issued by the United States Department of Agriculture for free and reduced fee lunch programs.

The scholarship program is available to Naperville Park District residents only.

An applicant must supply the Naperville Park District with copies of documentation of all forms of income they are currently receiving- i.e. recent pay stub, AFDC case #, a copy of recent IRS 1040 Form etc.

A scholarship may be issued for 6 months or one year. An applicant must reapply at the end of each calendar year in order to continue participation in the program. This program is not meant to be reapplied for more than 3 years.

New for 2008 Centennial Beach individual memberships and programs are eligible for full (100%) or partial (50%) scholarship. Programs available for scholarship include introductory or basic level programs with a maximum value of \$100. Trips, ticketed events and leagues are NOT eligible. Preschool is not eligible.

Naperville Park District reserves the right to approve full or partial funding or deny any applicant's request.

All information on the application must be true and accurate. Scholarships are legally recoverable if paid and awarded on the basis of false information supplied by the applicant and will nullify any request for waiver of fees.
