

Dear Naperville Gardeners,

In a recent email concerning the garden plots a resident referenced the Naperville Park District's new relationship with Player's Indoor Sports Center in the provision of lacrosse programs which utilize Park District fields. Below is an excerpt from the resident email.

“This maybe a real surprise for those who have thought that this issue was just between the SD and the PD. However, the Park District has made a commitment to team-up with the Players Indoor Sports Center to provide the outdoor Lacrosse fields for the club. In all of the discussion of this subject this was never mentioned. It was in the Chicago Tribune TribLocal edition on Thursday 1/1/09. See:

The information included in the email is misleading and we would like to take this opportunity to clarify that the Park District lacrosse programs scheduled to be offered with Player's Indoor Sports Center replace Park District offerings that have been provided for several years with another lacrosse vendor. The Naperville Park District made the determination to change vendors late in 2008. It is not an expansion of the Park District lacrosse programs that have been provided to the community for several years utilizing Park District fields, and the change in lacrosse vendors has had no bearing on the recent garden plots discussions.
