



Dear Season Reserved Tee Time Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in this 22-week golf program. Our reserved tee time lottery offers foursomes the chance to select a tee time at Springbrook Golf Course for play on either Saturday or Sunday throughout the 2010 golf season. Please read the policies that will govern this season's program and the lottery procedures. Groups familiar with the program will find little change from the 2009 season.

The *keep pace* goal for the Season Reserved Tee Time program is to allow all golfers to complete their round in 4 hours and 19 minutes or less. To accomplish this goal it is crucial that the earlier starting times play faster. The first group of each day is required to play in 4 hours or less. **Springbrook's *keep pace* policy has been modified specifically for the Season Reserved Tee Time program (see section 7-g). All groups are required to *keep pace*.**

All groups will be timed as they finish both the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes. Groups finishing the front 9 with a time exceeding 2 hours and 19 minutes and having an interval exceeding 10 minutes will not be allowed to continue their round. A voucher for the back 9 will be issued at that time. **No exceptions!**

Groups finishing the entire 22-week program with three or less infractions will be considered to have exemplary performance records. Groups with exemplary records will be given a lottery certificate valued at \$40 that is redeemable toward the 2011 Season Reserved Tee Time lottery fee.

The Springbrook Golf Course staff believes that following these policies will make your participation in the program a more enjoyable experience.

# 2010 Season Reserved Tee Time Regulations

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1. **2010 SEASON:** Season reserved weekend starting times are available from April 17 and 18 to September 25 and 26. **Please note season reserved weekend tee times will not be honored on June 5 and 6 and July 24 and 25.** These dates are for the Brooks Team Championship and the Naperville Men's City Championship, respectively.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** To participate in the Season Reserved Tee Time Lottery, all applicants must be Naperville Park District residents.
3. **TEE TIMES:** The program will reserve times at Springbrook Golf Course on both Saturday and Sunday. **Tee times will vary with the sunrise across the season. For the lottery, tee times will be based on times available in mid-season (5:50 a.m. - 12:06 p.m.).** A schedule of starting times will be posted in the clubhouse for reference. All tee times will be consecutive and will remain in their chosen sequence. **If any times are not chosen, all groups following will be moved up into those times to keep times consecutive.**
4. **APPLICATION PROCEDURES:**
  - a. Applications will be available at Springbrook Golf Course, Naperville Golf Course, the Naperville Park District Administration Building, and online at [springbrookgolfcourse.org](http://springbrookgolfcourse.org). **Applications must be returned to Springbrook Golf Course by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 22.**
  - b. A **\$100.00 NONREFUNDABLE registration fee** must accompany each application.
5. **LOTTERY PROCEDURES:**
  - a. The lottery drawing will be held at the **Alfred Rubin Riverwalk Community Center, 305 W. Jackson Avenue at 12:00 p.m., Sunday, February 28.**
  - b. **At least one member of the foursome or an individual representing the foursome must be present at the drawing to select a tee time.** If your group is not represented, your position in the lottery will be forfeited.
  - c. Each foursome representative will be assigned a number. The numbers will be placed in a container and drawn one at a time.
  - d. The representative for the foursome whose number is drawn will be given his choice of any available tee time for Saturday or Sunday between the hours of 5:50 a.m. to 12:06 p.m. ***We encourage faster groups to select the earlier tee times.***
  - e. The drawing will end after all numbers have been drawn.
6. **PAYMENT: PAYMENT FOR THE ENTIRE GROUP FOR THE SEASON IS DUE TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE PROGRAM ON SUNDAY, APRIL 4.** The fee for the program is \$4,136 for each reserved tee time. Make checks payable to **Springbrook Golf Course**. Payment may be made at Springbrook Golf Course any time prior to April 4.
7. **POLICIES FOR PLAY.**
  - a. **BROOKS LINKS MEMBERS:** Membership fee includes payment of up to 22 rounds in the Season Reserved Tee Time program. Senior Brooks Links Members are excluded. Members are required to pay an additional \$44 for Season Reserved Tee Time program fees regardless of the number of rounds played.



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- b. **CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:** All participants must register in the Golf Shop prior to teeing off. All golfers are required to present a receipt to the starter.
- c. **SUBSTITUTES:** All **NON-RESIDENT** substitute players will be required to pay the golf shop an additional \$5.00 fee if substituting for prepaid time or \$50 if substituting for a member's time. Brooks' Discount cardholder substitutes will be required to pay an additional fee of \$45. Groups will be issued a voucher if a member substitutes for a prepaid time. Groups are allowed unlimited substitutions.
- d. **VACANCIES:** Filling vacancies is the responsibility of the group. Each group will be issued an 18-hole voucher if they are unable to complete a foursome. This will be limited to two occasions per person or eight per group. Vouchers will be available the following weekend. Vacancies do not qualify for a refund to the group. If the group cannot fill a vacancy, please notify the Golf Shop. **Single players from the starter's lists are required to pay their green fee to the golf course.**
- e. **SINGLES:** The Springbrook Golf Course reserves the right to place singles with any group failing to fill its foursome when that group is scheduled to tee off. Groups refusing singles will be charged with "no-shows". If a group does not have vouchers remaining, the \$45 discounted green fee must be paid prior to teeing off.
- f. **REFUNDS:** Refunds are available only to groups that are canceling their tee time for the remainder of the season for the entire group.
- g. **KEEP PACE POLICY:** All groups will be timed from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee to the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> greens. Our pace goal is to have all Season Reserved Tee Time groups finish in 4 hours and 19 minutes or less. To accomplish our goal, the first group of each day must finish their round in 4 hours or less. The next sixteen groups (5:58 – 7:58) must finish their rounds in 4 hours and 10 minutes or less. The remaining groups must finish their rounds in 4 hours and 19 minutes or less. Groups also must finish their round within 10 minutes of the preceding group or the following interval combinations: if your interval is 11 minutes, no pace infraction will be charged if the sum of the intervals of your group and the preceding group is 20 minutes or less; for intervals of 12 or 13 minutes, no pace infractions will be charged if the sum of the intervals of your group and the preceding group is 18 minutes or less; for intervals of 14 minutes or more, an infraction will be charged. Failure to finish within the allotted time or the allotted interval is an infraction of this policy with a maximum of one infraction per week allowed. Three or less infractions over the 22 week season will entitle the group to receive a \$40 certificate. The certificate is redeemable toward the 2011 Season Reserved Tee Time lottery fee. **Any group having four infractions for exceeding maximum time or maximum interval after 9 or 18 holes will be moved to the last tee time of that day's reserved tee time program or will be issued a refund for the remainder of the season.** Groups finishing the front 9 with a time exceeding 2 hours and 19 minutes and having an interval exceeding 10 minutes, will not be allowed to continue their round. A voucher for the back 9 will be issued at that time. **No exceptions.**
- h. **DRESS CODE:** All participants will be required to wear proper golf attire (e.g. collared shirts and khaki pants/shorts). Tank tops and cut-off shorts are not acceptable. Anyone found to be in violation of the dress code will be required to make the appropriate modification.

- Only one application may be submitted for each foursome. No names may be submitted on more than one application. All applications will be screened for duplications. **Duplications will be rejected.**
