

Dear Naperville Gardener,

On April 21st Naperville City Council approved amendments to the Park District lease agreements for DuPage River Park and the West Street properties. The amendments allow for a change in land use at each of the respective parks to accommodate the development of new garden plots at DuPage River Park and the re-development of a portion of the West Street Garden Plots based on the Option 1A concept. The Thursday, May 14th Naperville Park District Board of Commissioners meeting is scheduled to include an agenda item to accept the same lease agreement amendments approved by City Council. The meeting will take place at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of the Naperville Municipal Center, 400 S. Eagle Street.

Approval of the lease agreement amendments allows for a change in land use at each of the park sites. Development of garden plots at DuPage River Park and the re-development of a portion of the West Street Garden Plots is also contingent upon the approval of a mutually acceptable Intergovernmental Use Agreement between the Park District and School District 203.
