

Dear Naperville Gardener,

This summer the Naperville Park District hosted two public open houses to gather resident input on design plans for garden plots at West Street and DuPage River Park. Resident comments received at each of the respective open houses were compiled by the Park District and are posted on our website under the Garden Plots project webpage. The feedback continues to be considered by the Park District as we refine the design plans for each of the sites. Updated design plans and project timelines will be communicated as additional information becomes available.

The Park District also is in the process of forming a Garden Plots Discussion Group consisting of up to 12 current gardeners. The purpose of the discussion group will be to generate ideas and suggestions related to the following:

- Registration methods for relocated and new garden plots
- Future garden plot sizes/offerings
- Garden plot site amenities

If you are interested in participating in the garden plots discussion group, please e-mail the Park District at info@napervilleparks.org with the subject heading: "Garden Plots Discussion Group." In the email please include your name, address, number of years you have participated in the garden plots program, and the number of plots you currently maintain. The discussion group will be limited to no more than 12 participants. Location of participant plots, number of years within the program, and the number of plots maintained will be considered by the Park District during the selection of discussion group participants in order to have diverse representation within the group.
