NAPERVILLE PARK DISTRICT TENNIS COURT RULES

- 1. Courts are to be used for tennis only. No bicycles, scooters, skateboards or inline skates are allowed.**
- 2. Tennis shoes are required.**
- 3. Play is limited to 1 hour for singles and 1 ½ hours for doubles when others are waiting. There is a maximum of four players per court at all times.**
- 4. Players may not hold courts while others are waiting. All players waiting for a court must remain outside the tennis court fence.**
- 5. Non-players and spectators must remain outside the fence.**
- 6. Naperville Park District authorized lessons and tournaments as well as high school practices and matches have priority over public play at all times. For information on schedules contact the Naperville Park District at 630-848-5000.**
- 7. Tennis lessons (instruction, drills, clinics) may only be given by authorized Naperville Park District personnel.**
- 8. Ball hoppers and ball machines are not permitted on the tennis courts except during Naperville Park District programs.**
- 9. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. No food, glass containers or smoking on the tennis courts.**
- 10. Tennis court hours of operation are from sunrise to sunset. Our lighted facilities operate from sunrise until 10:00 pm.**
- 11. All Naperville Park District ordinances apply.**
