



Naperville Premier Soccer League (NPSL)

Who:

Kids in 2nd grade through 7th/8th grade

What:

Naperville Premier Soccer League (NPSL) is a soccer league designed for players that want to play soccer in a competitive environment without committing to the expense and travel of club soccer. In addition outside club teams may participate in the NPSL.

- Teams may choose from 5 different options:
- League play only.
- League play with a certified trainer for ten weeks, one hour long sessions and parent coach at games.
- League play with trainer 2 x per week training sessions and parent coach at games.
- League play with full time trainer coach 1x per training session and game.
- League play with full time trainer coach 2 x per week trainer sessions and game.

Fee:

Grades 2-3-4

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,220 per team.
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$1,968 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$2,510 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$2,604 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game:\$3,178 per team

Grades 5-6

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,394 per team
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$2,245 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$2,747 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$2,850 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game: \$3,454 per team

Grades 7-8

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,527
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$2,395 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$3,000 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$3,126 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game: \$3,670 per team

Rules:

Grades 2-3-4:	7v7 – 14 maximum on roster
Grades 5-6:	9v9 – 16 maximum on roster
Grades 7/8:	11v11 – 18 maximum on roster

Registration:

ONLINE REGISTRATION IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR NAPERVILLE PREMIER SOCCER LEAGUE

Registration will be accepted on a team basis only.

Drop off a registration form beginning Monday, November 25 at the Alfred Ruben Riverwalk Center, 95th Street or Fort Hill Activity Center front desk locations.

Payment must be made at the time of registration. A \$200 non-refundable deposit or full payment is required. Balance must be paid by February 15, 2020.

NEW TEAMS: Please submit a **New Team Training Registration Form** along with your Naperville Park District Program Guide registration form and payment. The New Team Registration Form can be found under the forms tab at: napervillepremiersoccerleague.org.

Training slots for new teams will be assigned on a first come first served basis based on the open training slots. Slots will be filled in the order in which registrations are received.

Returning teams will have the option to retain previous training slot or the ability to change time slots before new teams if registration forms are received by December 6.





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Head Coach or Team Manager will receive additional information in mid-January on how to complete individual

Teams may select from the following registration options

Option 1:	League play only
Option 2:	League play with certified trainer once weekly/parent volunteer to coach games
Option 3:	League play with certified trainer twice weekly/ parent volunteer to coach games
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer/coach 2 x per week and game

player registration, coach and team paperwork.

Teams registering for option 1 will determine their own practice schedule and location.

Teams selecting the training option may pick from the following possible locations, days and times listed below. Training slots will be filled on a first come, first served basis based upon registration date and time. Some locations may have limited availability and if your first or second choice is not available, the NPSL coordinator will contact you about other possible options.

Training sessions will be one hour per week for ten weeks beginning March 23. Additional practices and locations will be determined by the coach.

Arrowhead Park	Mon.-Fri.	4:00/5:15/6:30

Training session time slots may be added or deleted as needed based on number of teams that sign up.

Games:

An 8-week game schedule will be played beginning April 11 and ending June 6. No games will be played over Memorial Day Weekend. All games will be played in Naperville on Saturdays. There is a possibility of weekday games if an odd number of teams sign within any grade level. Rain date is June 13 for those games cancelled by the Park District. Game scores and standing will be kept. Awards will be given to first

and second place teams at the end of the season. Equal play time is encouraged but not guaranteed; play time will be based on coaching strategy.

Hosting a Trainer:

We are looking for host families to provide ten weeks of housing for our trainers during their stay. Families may host for the entire ten weeks or share with other families in weekly increments.

ADDITIONAL INFO:

Teams will provide their own equipment. Home team is required to provide game ball. It is suggested that each team also have a first aid kit (bandages, gloves, and ice packs).

Uniform choice will be determined by team. The only requirements are that each team must have a home and away jersey, jerseys must have numbers on back and team is uniform in jersey, shorts and socks.

NYS blue/gold reversible jerseys may be worn but numbers must be placed on the back. Teams may choose to purchase uniforms on their own or select from options available through Naperville Premiere Soccer League program.

1. Team registration is open to anyone that is interested in playing. Teams may be composed of residents and/or non-residents. Nonresidents must pay an additional \$20 fee payable to the Naperville Park District. Players playing on a club team also may play in the Premier league. Club teams may sign up and wear their club uniform.
2. Registration is on a team basis only; interested individuals will be placed on an interest list provided to teams looking for additional players. Placing your name on the interest list does not guarantee that you will be placed on a team.
3. Grade levels may be combined if a sufficient number of teams do not sign up.
4. New players and coaches must come to the park district offices at either 95th Street or the Fort Hill Activity Center and obtain a player pass before the start of the season. Coach will provide additional information after team is registered.
