



Naperville Premier Soccer League (NPSL)

Who:

Kids in 2nd grade through 7th/8th grade

What:

Naperville Premier Soccer League (NPSL) is a soccer league designed for players that want to play soccer in a competitive environment without committing to the expense and travel of club soccer. Club teams may also register.

Teams may select from the following options

Option 1:	League play only
Option 2:	League play with certified trainer once weekly/parent volunteer to coach games
Option 3:	League play with certified trainer twice weekly/ parent volunteer to coach games
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer/coach 2 x per week and game

Team Fee:

Grades 2-3-4

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,220 per team.
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$1,968 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$2,510 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$2,604 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game:\$3,178 per team

Grades 5-6

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,394 per team
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$2,245 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$2,747 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$2,850 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game: \$3,454 per team

Grades 7-8

Option 1:	League play only: \$1,527
Option 2:	League play with trainer 1 x per week with parent game coach: \$2,395 per team
Option 3:	League play with trainer 2x per week with parent game coach: \$3,000 per team
Option 4:	League play with full time trainer/coach 1 x per week and game: \$3,126 per team
Option 5:	League play with full time trainer /coach 2 x per week and game: \$3,670 per team

Training Sessions:

Teams registering for option 1 (league play only) will determine their own practice schedule and location. Lights will not be provided for those teams choosing option 1.

Training slots for teams that choose option #2-#5 will be filled on a first come, first served basis based upon registration date and time. Some locations may have limited availability and if your first or second choice is not available, the NPSL coordinator will contact you about other possible options. Priority will be given to returning teams to secure previous seasons location if team signs up during 1st week of registration.

Training sessions will be one hour per week for ten weeks beginning August 24. Additional practices and locations will be determined by the coach.

Games:

An 8-week game schedule will be played beginning September 12. All games will be played in Naperville on Saturdays. Rain date is November 7 for those games cancelled by the Park District. Game scores and standing will be kept. Awards will be given to first and second place teams at the end of the season. Equal play time is encouraged but not guaranteed; play time will be based on coaching strategy.



Registration Information:

There are two ways to register for the NPSL league.

Team registration. Coaches will register their team online choosing the option and course code that corresponds to their selection.

A \$200 non-refundable deposit or full payment is required at time of registration. Balance will be due July 13, 2020 and is non-refundable at this point.

All teams should be registered by July 13, 2020.

Individual registration. Players in grades 2-6 that do not have a team and would like to play and may sign up for a team on their own. Teams will have a dedicated Challenger trainer as their coach and will practice one time per week. Volunteer assistant coaches and/or team managers are needed for each team. Early registration is recommended as space is limited. The last day to register or cancel and receive a refund is July 3, 2020.

Fee per person is \$285 resident and \$305 for non-resident. A uniform is included in the league fee.

Practices will begin August 24. All individual teams will practice at Frontier S.C.

Additional Info:

1. Teams will provide their own equipment. Home team is required to provide game ball. It is suggested that each team also have a first aid kit (bandages, gloves, and ice packs).

2. Uniform choice will be determined by team. The only requirements are that each team must have a home and away jersey, jerseys must have numbers on back and team is uniform in jersey, shorts and socks.

NYS blue/gold reversible jerseys may be worn but numbers must be placed on the back. Teams may choose to purchase uniforms on their own or select from options available through Naperville Premiere Soccer League program.

3. Registration is open to anyone that is interested in playing. Teams may be composed of residents and/or non-residents. Nonresidents must pay an additional \$20 fee payable to the Naperville Park District. Players playing on a club team also may play in the Premier league. Club teams may sign up and wear their club uniform.

4. Grade levels may be combined if a sufficient number of teams do not sign up.

5. New players and coaches must come to the park district offices at either 95th Street or the Fort Hill Activity Center and obtain a player pass before the start of the season. Coach will provide additional information after team is registered.

6. Teams are grade based. Teams must consist of 2/3's of players from grade signed up for. Players may play "up" one year but number is limited to 1/3 of team roster. Players may not play "down" in grade level even if age is same of those players in lower grade.

Roster Size:

Grades 2-3-4:	7v7 – 14 maximum on roster
Grades 5-6:	9v9 – 16 maximum on roster
Grades 7/8:	11v11 – 18 maximum on roster
