



## Sportsman's Park Safety Rules

- Steel shotshells ONLY!
- Maximum shot size: #6
- Max load 1-1/8oz of shot; Target-load equivalent shells only.
- All shotshells are subject to inspection by the Range Officer.
- Use of, or possession of, lead shotshells on the range is unlawful. (*NPD Conduct Ordinance #641*)
- Only 12 gauge shotguns or smaller.
- Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all shooters.
- Shooting is prohibited unless a Range Officer is on duty.
- Guns must be unloaded and the chamber kept open at all times except when a shooter is on a firing station. Break-action shotguns may be closed for storage, but must be opened immediately upon removal from the rack or case.
- Guns must be unloaded when changing stations.
- Only one shell is to be loaded at a time and only when it is the shooter's turn to shoot. (Exception: Two shells may be loaded when shooting doubles.)
- Read and obey all posted range rules and obey all range commands – ***Immediately!***
- Orange cone indicates a person downrange. Your gun must be unloaded, the action open and muzzle pointed in a safe direction when the orange cone is visible on your trap.
- Do not pick up discarded shell casings while the squad is shooting.
- Never discard a live or misfired shell onto the ground: notify the Range Officer and dispose of in the proper manner.
- Inexperienced shooters are required to be assisted by an experienced shooter.
- Minors must be supervised at all times.
- Dry pointing is only permitted within the range area and only in a safe direction.
- Cell phone use is prohibited on the range.
- Know and follow all other firearm safety regulations and practices.
- Safety first, common sense and courtesy at all times.

*Violation of rules may result in immediate ejection from the facility.*
