



FRONTIER SPORTS COMPLEX SKATE FACILITY SAFETY RULES

Non-motorized in-line skates, skateboards, scooters and bikes only at this facility. Bikes have priority use of the facility on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4 p.m. until sunset. In-line skates, skateboards and scooters have priority use of the facility at all other times. For safety purposes skaters and bikers cannot use the facility at the same time. Users must exit the facility when they do not have priority use.

CAUTION: In-line skating, skateboards, use of scooters and biking are high-risk, recreational activities with inherent risks of serious injury.

FACILITY RULES

In the event that rules are not being followed, the Naperville Park District may elect to temporarily or permanently close this facility.

1. The facility will be open from 8:00 a.m. to sunset during the skating season.
2. It is required that proper protective equipment, such as a helmet, wristguards, elbow pads, kneepads, etc., be used during skating activities.
3. Bike use is limited to BMX style bikes only, no mountain bikes.
4. Metal bike pegs are not allowed. Plastic pegs or pegs with insulated sleeves only.
5. Other wheeled or sliding devices, and persons not skating are not allowed to use the skating equipment.
6. No personally owned apparatus, such as ramps, boxes, etc., may be brought into or used at the facility.
7. Be courteous of neighbors and other park users. Profanity and loud music is not allowed in or around the facility.
8. Food and glass containers are not permitted in the skating area.
9. No smoking or tobacco use.
10. All users are responsible for inspecting equipment prior to use to ensure that no hazards are present. Do not use broken equipment or wet equipment. Report any needed repairs to the Naperville Park District at 630-848-5000.
11. Do not use the shade pavilion as a shelter during inclement weather.
12. The Park District reserves the right to close the facility at any time without advanced notice.

No trespassing during non-use hours or when the facility is closed.

Violators are subject to fine or suspension per Naperville Park District Conduct Ordinance #641.
