



Phase 4 Participation Guidelines

Farmers Market

The following participation guidelines apply to the Naperville Park District 95th Street Farmers Market during the 2020 season. Information from the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity Phase 4 Guidelines, in addition to information from public health organizations, was used in the development of the guidelines. The guidelines are subject to change as new information becomes available.

Park District Staff

- Staff will be provided instruction/education on COVID-19 prevention.
- All staff must perform a self-assessment daily and not report to work if they are ill or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. If an individual begins to exhibit symptoms during the program they must be isolated from others.*
- If a staff member has symptoms they must wait to enter the premises until they have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared, OR until feverless and feeling well (without fever-reducing medication) for at least 72 hours OR confirmed to not have COVID-19 via 2 negative COVID-19 tests in a row, with testing done at least 24 hours apart.*
- Staff are required to wear a face covering while in the Farmers Market and when a minimum 6 foot distance cannot be maintained from others.
- Staff are encouraged to wash hands or sanitize upon arrival to the market and upon leaving. Frequent handwashing breaks are encouraged.

Vendors

- Vendors and their employees must conduct a self-assessment and not attend the market if they are ill or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. If an individual begins to exhibit symptoms during the Farmers Market they must be isolated from others before leaving.*
- If a vendor has symptoms they must wait to enter the premises until they have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared, OR until feverless and feeling well (without fever-reducing medication) for at least 72 hours OR confirmed to not have COVID-19 via 2 negative COVID-19 tests in a row, with testing done at least 24 hours apart.*

**Per the CDC, symptoms include cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting and diarrhea.*

- Vendors and their employees are required to wear a face covering and gloves while in the Farmers Market and when a minimum 6 foot distance cannot be maintained from others.
- Handwashing or sanitizing is required upon arrival to the market and frequent handwashing breaks throughout the market are encouraged.
- No sampling of products are allowed.
- Whenever possible handle the products for the customer.
- If customer is using their own reusable bag have a table set aside where the customer can bag their own products.
- No exchange of change. Credit/debit cards and **exact** cash accepted.
- Follow prescribed state and local food safety procedures for all products offered for sale.

Customers

- Customers must conduct a self-assessment daily and not attend the program if they are ill or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. If an individual begins to exhibit symptoms during the program they must be isolated from others until they leave the premises.*
- If a customer has symptoms, they must wait to enter the premises until they have had no fever for at least 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since their symptoms first appeared.
- Customers are required to wear a face covering at all times while in the Farmers Market and when a minimum 6 foot distance cannot be maintained from others outside of the market.
- Hand washing or hand sanitizing are recommended before and after visiting the market.

Market Details

- Signage displaying the market rules, including face covering requirements and social distancing guidelines will be placed at the entrance into the market area.
- Market area capacity will be limited and based on available space and the ability to social distance between customers.
- One entrance/exit area will be provided to control the number of customers in the market area at a time.
- Face coverings are required while in the market and whenever 6 feet of social distancing is not possible.
- Vendor booths will be setup to promote social distancing, allowing 6 feet of additional space for customers to safely wait in line.
- No sampling of products will be allowed. Food items purchased must be grab and go and not consumed on site.
- No gathering, sitting or lingering will be allowed.
- If customer is using their own reusable bag they will be required to place the products in the bag.
- All products purchased should be washed before eating or using.
